## The Festival of Trees-20th Anniversary

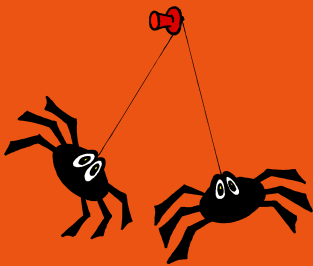

## Watch Your Back!

When it comes to being an electrician your back is being exercised a lot. Your back can be injured in many ways, not just from picking up heavy loads. People who are in poor physical condition or do work that includes heavy labor or long periods of sitting or standing are

at greater risk for low back problems. These people also get better more slowly. Emotional stress or long periods of inactivity may make back symptoms seem worse. Test every load before you lift it by pushing the object lightly with your hands or feet, doing this, will give you a good idea as to how heavy

it may be. Make sure that when you are carrying the object it is balanced and packed so it won't move around. Keep the object that you are carrying close to yours body, the farther the object is from your body increases the amount of strain on your back.
